1. Brown Brother's Crouchen Riesling (Australia) – Medium Sweet

Crouchen grapes balanced naturally by the acidity of the Riesling grapes. Aromas of pear, tropical fruits and citrus, an extremely versatile food wine.

2. Terralis Chardonnay Torronttes (Argentina) – Medium

Rich flavours of tropical fruit from the Chardonnay, combined with intense notes evocative of aniseed and flowers emblematic of Torronttes

3. Terralis Shiraz Malbec (Argentina)

Two of the most noble grapes in a superb blend. Spicy shiraz with the intense colour and fruitiness of the Malbec.

4. Norte Chico Sauvignon Blanc (Chile) – Dry

6. Sutter Home White Zinfandel (California) – Medium

A delicate blush pink in colour, with aromas of strawberries and watermelon. The wine is fresh, lively and bursting with fruit, to be enjoyed with all types of food.

7. Goyenechea Merlot Rosè (Argentina) – Dry

Delightful rosè made with merlot grapes, a dry wine with an abundance of mouth filling strawberry fruit flavours and a fresh finish

8. Wakefield Unwooded Chardonnay (Australia) – Dry

This wine has a clean fresh varietal flavour due to the fact it is unwooded.

9. Bradgate Chenin Sauvignon Blanc (South Africa) – Medium

Tropical pear flavours of the Chenin Blanc compliment the fig and green pepper of the grassy Sauvignon Blanc. This wine has a crisp elegant finish.

10. Pinot Grigio Vallade (Italy) – Dry

Lively, fresh fruity bouquet, with a dry smooth palate and a clean dry finish. Great with fish, poultry, pasta and salads.

11. Norte Chico Chardonnay (Chile) – Dry

An excellent quality un-oaked chardonnay bursting with flavour of grapefruit, pineapple, peach and melon, with a soft finish

12. Torres Santa Digna Sauvignon Blanc (Chile) – Dry

A bouquet of ripe tropical fruits, with a background of apple and fennel. A dry and silky varietal flavour

13. Saint Clair Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand) – Dry

Intense aromas of passion fruit, blackcurrant gooseberry and lime. Fabulous with fish or light summer dishes

14. Sandpiper Reserve Chardonnay, Viognier, Sauvignon (France) – Dry

A dynamic tri-band gives a result to be proud of. Chardonnay with a warm touch of oak, the Viognier a touch of tropical fruit, the Sauvignon is fresh and crisp on the finish. New World meets Old World.

15. Chablis 1er Cru 'Beuroy' – Domaine Hamelin (France) – Dry

Coming from the Premier Cru area it has a rich dry style with hints of citrus and apple and a fragrance of fresh mown hay.

Red Wines

16. Wakefield Estate Shiraz (Australia)

A flavoursome Shiraz with ripe berry, spice and plum characters. Balanced with coffee and creamy vanilla

17. Fontella Sangiovese Di Puglia (Italy)

Rich ruby red in colour with aromas of cherry. A delightfully fruity red with a long complex finish.

18. Bradgate Syrah (South Africa)

A complex flavour spectrum of violets, sweet ripe plums and wild scrub with nuances of crushed pepper and bay leaf. Maturation in oak adds a smokiness to the savoury fruitcake finish

19. Horse Mountain Pinotage (South Africa)

Bursting with fruit, quite unlike any other Pinotage from South Africa

20. Torres Santa Digna Cabernet Sauvignon (Chile)

A deep opaque cherry colour, varietal aromas typical of the great Pacific Cabernet Sauvignons, on the palate it is full bodied with soft tannins

21. Amayna Pinot Noir (Chile)

The influence of the sea and soil combined with the slow ripening make for a deep ruby red wine with a touch of violet and great aromatic complexity

22. Sandpiper Reserve Grenache, Malbec, Shiraz (France)

Low yielding Grenache give power, Malbec gives structure and intensity of black summer fruits and the shiraz delivers spice and soft tannin structure.

23. Chateâuneuf du Pape Rouge A.C. Domaine Chanssaud (France)

Big powerful wine with a firmness of complex fruit mingled with hints of spice, liquorice and blackberries, ideal with roast meats, game and sharp cheeses.

24. Mirador Navajas Crianza Rioja (Spain)

Light ruby red in colour with cherry, blackcurrant and vanilla notes. It is medium bodied with lively berry fruit, with a rich vanilla aftertaste.

Sparkling Wine

25. Willow Glen Sparkling Brut (Australia) – Dry

A sparkling wine made with the cuvee close method. Only Muscat Grapes grown in the district of Asti in Northern Italy are used

26. Fresita (Argentina)

Fresh, natural strawberry pulp is added to the sparkling wine before being bottled thus creating, a fine, pleasant blend of aromas that result in a balanced and attractive product, very suitable as a dessert wine.

27. Phillippe Desloge

A high quality house champagne produced from chardonnay and Pinot Noir grapes. A ripe fruit taste with a clean dry finish.

This non-vintage champagne maintains a light, dry style which rounds out nicely with age giving a good strong mousse.

29. Laurent Perrier Brut

Company policy is to use most of the best wines in the non-vintage blends rather than reserving them for the vintage cuvees. This champagne has good length and a subtle dry finish

30. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label

Admired for its quality and maturity. It is full of flavour and a long distinctive fruity aftertaste

31. Pol Roger Vintage Reserve

Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay give this champagne a full rich style. A favourite of Sir Winston Churchill

32. Fresnet-Juliet Brut Rosè Grand Cru N.V.

A fruit driven style of champagne reflected in the salmon pink colour, full of summer fruit flavours

33. Louis Roderer – Cristal

Intense nose of white flowers, citrus and red berries, followed by warmer whiffs of toast and wood. On the palate, ripe lush fruits (vine peaches) and toasty flavours.

Dense, fleshy structure. Powerful finish.
